Continue on to Yarrangobilly Caves and visit the beautiful Jillabentan Cave with its amazing decorations. Access is very easy to this with only 4 steps. Return to the lodge for afternoon tea, and dinner at 6.30pm. BLD

**Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> April**. Country Cowboys & Cowgirls.

Depart for Tumbarumba along the scenic Elliot Way via Cabramurra, Australia's highest town. Morning Tea is at the spectacular Paddy's Falls. Continue on to Boggy Creek Farm for the highlight of the trip. We will be entertained by sheep, dogs, horses, cattle and a few surprises. Have lunch and real billy-tea. Return to the lodge for dinner – overnight. BLD

**Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> April** . Chair to the top. Thredbo and Mt Kosciusko.

Drive via Berridale and Jindabyne to Thredbo where we will board the chairlift and travel to the top of the world for spectacular views of the Snowy Mountains. Lunch at Jindabyne and then onto Charlotte Pass. View Australia's highest peaks including Mt Kosciuszko. Tour of Adaminaby and see the buildings moved from the old town. BLD

**Friday . 23<sup>rd</sup> April** .After a hearty breakfast, and bidding our hosts a fond farewell. If time permits. A brief stop will be made at the Snowy Mountains Authority, Canberra for lunch.
